THIMBLEBERRIES 2008 QUILT CLUB quilt is "Lodge" or "Lakeside". The "Lodge" fabric collection is the more traditional dark Thimbleberries colors. The "Lakeside" fabric collection is a little lighter and has some blues.

The "Lodge" or "Lakeside" Big Club Quilts are made using elements from four single patterns. These four smaller projects will be available with or without kits – you do not need to be a club member to purchase these four patterns. The "Lodge" and "Lakeside" Big club quilt **instructions** are **exclusive** to club members.

Our Thimbleberries Club meets twice a month – the last Monday evening of each month and the next Tuesday morning. Even if you don't sign up for the big club quilt, you can join Thimbleberries Club. Our group does many fun projects and exchanges. Stop in and check out a meeting.

NEW BLOCK A MONTH - THIMBLEBERRIES BLOCK A MONTH *Thimbleberries Village* is from the book *Big Book of Quilt Blocks*. You will complete a 80" x 102" quilt in 12 months.

Classes will be the last Tuesday of each month following the Thimbleberries Quilt Club meetings. You will need to bring your sewing machine and basic supplies.

Kits will be available for anyone including non members for \$8.00. If you are a Club Member and you purchase your kit on the day of the Club meeting the discounted price will be \$6.00. (Book required)

Karen Baker will be the instructor.

SUPER SUNDAY 2008 (Jan. - Dec): We will be doing our Super Sunday Program again this year. The new series is a 12" finished star block, and we offer a "Hearts & Flowers" applique block each month.

This is how the program works: Your first pieced block may be purchased any time in January for \$5.00. The following month, on the first Sunday, you bring back the finished block and you get the next block **free**. To get your free kit each month, you have to come on the first Sunday of the month.

If you can't come one Sunday, you can buy that month's kit for \$5 while supplies last. The "Hearts & Flowers" block will be \$6.00

"Home for the Holidays"

This new line of patterns includes a pieced house with twelve applique blocks depicting holiday themes. These designs are sure to instill a longing to be "home for the holidays".

Each "Home for the Holidays" pattern includes instructions for a 16" x 20" applique block and a 10" x 20" pieced block (finished sizes). Month 12 includes instructions for completing the quilt top. You must purchase the finishing kit to participate.

BUCK A BLOCK SERIES 4:

Our Buck a Block series continues thru June, 2008. The blocks are 8" finished and use 2" Thangles. You can choose to make either batik or oriental blocks.

Come in any time during the month and purchase **one** kit and pattern for \$1. You may purchase additional kits for \$3. Only one Buck a Block each month **per person** for \$1. You must personally pick up your block. If you pick up for another person you will pay \$3. We also have border kits, with pattern, available. Border kits use 4" Thangles.

CHRISTMAS CLUB

This club meets once a month on the 2nd Wednesday from 6-8 p.m. If you enjoy working on and most often completing a small project, this club is for you.

To participate you are required to purchase a project kit for the item we are making that month. They are generally inexpensive. There is no fee to be part of the club.
